#### **WATCHING THE SKIES**

Our ships are constantly on the lookout for nature's breathtaking display of lights. Announcements are made to passengers on board when there is a sighting so that you can rush out on deck to enjoy the show, which can last anything from a few precious minutes to more than an hour of dancing colours.

\*If on your 12-day voyage the Northern Lights don't occur, you have 28 days after returning from your voyage to book a 6-day Classic Voyage South or 7-day Classic Voyage North, departing between 1 October 2017 to 31 March 2018 in an unspecified inside twin cabin on a half-board basis. A Northern Lights occurrence is defined as a sighting from the ship which is recorded by the ship's deck officers and which is announced to passengers on board. An occurrence can last anything from a few minutes to a matter of hours, and the ship's decision as to whether or not the Northern Lights occurred is final. Hurtigruten reserves the right to withdraw or amend this offer at any time.

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# A winter WONDERLAND

THE WINTER MONTHS IN NORWAY ARE SOMETHING TRULY SPECIAL, AND ADVENTURE IS MOST DEFINITELY IN THE AIR ABOVE THE ARCTIC CIRCLE.

## THE COSMIC COAST

Stand amazed as the graceful *aurora borealis* weaves its rainbow of colours across the starlit Arctic sky. Although this spectacular display can't be guaranteed, the best time to catch it is from October to March, and from the deck of a Hurtigruten ship far from artificial ambient light.

## DAYLIGHT SPENDING

The longer hours of darkness in the winter form the perfect backdrop for the Northern Lights, but there is still enough light to view the magnificent mountains and fjords too. Even in the darkest months of December and January, Tromsø within the Arctic Circle has the sun hovering just below the horizon to create prolonged twilight, made brighter by the white of freshly fallen snow. Either side of December and January, daylight increases by about four or five hours each month, eventually reaching 24 hours for the Midnight Sun at the peak of summer.

## SNOW-SCAPES AND ICE-CAPADES

With snowfall almost guaranteed within the Arctic Circle in winter, the landscape transforms into a pristine and pure white blanket. Streets bustle with traditional Scandinavian Yuletide markets, giant gingerbread houses, and sometimes even reindeer-drawn sleighs in the snow. Start your engine and speed through the snowy scenery on a snowmobile or lead a pack of friendly husky dogs on an exhilarating sledge-ride. The very cool Snowhotel in Kirkenes should also be visited, before it melts away in the spring.

## NORDIC NOSH

Wintertime in Norway is also the season of sumptuous seafood, when cod, halibut, salmon, trout, prawns, langoustines, blue mussels, scallops, and lobsters are at their freshest flavours. Traditional dishes based on mutton, pork, and venison are also local favourites, especially in the run-up to the holiday season.

# Life ON BOARD



THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION GIVES YOU SOME PRACTICAL INSIGHTS INTO WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT ON BOARD WITH HURTIGRUTEN.

### Meals

- Breakfast (open seating) from 7:30am
  - Lunch (open seating) from 12pm
  - Dinner (assigned seating) from 6:30pm
- Special diets e.g. vegetarian can be catered for if requested in advance. Passengers on stricter diets e.g. vegan may find there is a limited choice of dishes suitable for them.

### Gratuity

It is not common practice to tip on Hurtigruten voyages along Norway's coast, but there are tip boxes with envelopes if you wish to reward crew members for exceptional service.

### Languages

Norwegian and English are the official on-board languages.

### Safety

The safety of each and every one of our passengers is our top priority. All guests must attend a compulsory safety briefing before embarkation.

### Medical Assistance

There is no doctor or pharmacy on board. However, officers are trained in first aid and our ships are never far from land should emergency medical assistance be required.

### Smoking

Smoking is not permitted in cabins and only allowed in designated areas on the outside decks, except when the ship is in port and refuelling.

### Mobility

We are happy to welcome passengers who are not fully mobile and all ships (except MS Lofoten) have at least one cabin equipped for



travellers using a wheelchair. Some excursions, however, may not be suitable for those with limited mobility.

### Luggage handling

Luggage handling is not included. Apart from departures from the Hurtigruten Terminal in Bergen, you will need to carry your own luggage on and off the ship.

### Shop

There is a shop on board all ships selling local products, souvenirs, knitwear, books, postcards, postage stamps, and a limited supply of toiletries.

### Laundry

All ships have laundry rooms that are equipped with washing machines, dryers, and irons, with tokens purchased at reception.

### Internet

There is an internet café on all ships, except for MS Lofoten. Wi-Fi is available in most public areas. Some ships will charge for use of the Wi-Fi.

### Working Vessels

Hurtigruten is a lifeline to the 34 communities we visit, bringing vital cargo that supports these thriving cities, towns, and hamlets. It is possible that some cabins on the ships may experience some noise and vibration during the docking and loading of goods.

### GEAR UP

All specialist gear such as polar jackets are provided for certain excursions like snowmobiling, but you'll still want to ensure you come ready for your voyage with your own kit too.

Here are some practical suggestions:

1. Sturdy shoes, detachable shoe spikes, and trekking pole
2. Multiple layers of thermal wear
3. Waterproof and windproof clothing
4. Warm gloves, hat, and scarf
5. Binoculars (for bird and whale watching)
6. UV protective sunglasses (for sun glare from snow)
7. Good camera with neck / wrist safety cord
8. Extra camera batteries and memory cards
9. 220v AC Two-pin plug and socket adaptor / converter
10. Small amount of Norwegian Kroner (NOK) in cash



### WEATHER WEAR

All attire on board our ships is informal and there is no dress code. While the ships are very well heated, do note that temperatures up in the Arctic Circle can drop to as low as -20°C or lower in the winter wind. We therefore recommend wearing multiple layers and to bring good quality windproof, thermal clothing to keep you warm and toasty throughout your voyage.

Hurtigruten's golden age of exploration has also expanded to new horizons, at the top of the world – Spitsbergen, Iceland, Greenland, Canada – and due south at the other end of the earth – the Amazon, Brazil, Patagonia, and Antarctica. We also have voyages across Europe and down to North Africa, and transatlantic routes from Morocco to Brazil.



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
