WATCHING THE SKIES

Our ships are constantly on the lookout for nature's breathtaking display of lights. Announcements are made to passengers on board when there is a sighting so that you can rush out on deck to enjoy the show, which can last anything from a few precious minutes to more than an hour of dancing colours.

*If on your 12-day voyage the Northern Lights don't occur, you have 28 days after returning from your voyage to book a 6-day Classic Voyage South or 7-day Classic Voyage North, departing between 1 October 2017 to 31 March 2018 in an unspecified inside twin cabin on a half-board basis. A Northern Lights occurrence is defined as a sighting from the ship which is recorded by the ship's deck officers and which is announced to passengers on board. An occurrence can last anything from a few minutes to a matter of hours, and the ship's decision as to whether or not the Northern Lights occurred is final. Hurtigruten reserves the right to withdraw or amend this offer at any time.

THE COSMIC COAST

Stand amazed as the graceful *aurora borealis* weaves its rainbow of colours across the starlit Arctic sky. Although this spectacular display can't be guaranteed, the best time to catch it is from October to March, and from the deck of a Hurtigruten ship far from artificial ambient light.

DAYLIGHT SPENDING

The longer hours of darkness in the winter form the perfect backdrop for the Northern Lights, but there is still enough light to view the peak of summer.

With snowfall almost guaranteed within the Arctic Circle in winter, the landscape transforms into a pristine and pure white blanket. 




Medical Assistance
