

DAYBYDAY

Day 1: Saturday - LAS PALMAS DE GRAN CANARIA

Embarkation between 2.30 pm and 4.00pm. Enjoy a welcome drink followed by an evening dinner. Overnight at sea to Los Cristianos port – South Tenerife.

Day 2 : Sunday - LOS CRISTIANOS PORT, SOUTH TENERIFE

Morning arrival in Los Cristianos Port, South Tenerife. Enjoy swimming at nearby beaches or go on an optional half day excursion to Mount Teide. This fantastic tour begins with an ascent from sea-level to 2370 meters into Cañadas National Park, where we find the highest peak in Spain.

Day 3 : Monday - SANTA CRUZ DE LA PALMA

Early morning arrival in Santa Cruz de la Palma. <u>Optional full day excursion</u> visiting the historic old town of Santa Cruz de La Palma and to TABURIENTE NA-TIONAL PARK to visit the museum and the crater itself (weather permitting). A visit to EL PASO, a nice traditional Canary village will take place just in time before we stop in a restaurant for an inclusive lunch.

Day 4 : Tuesday- VALLE GRAN REY, LA GOMERA – SANTA CRUZ DE TENERIFE

Early morning sailing and arrival in Valle Gran Rey, La Gomera Island. Optional half day excursion passing through the villages of Arure and Valle Hermoso to reach the small village of Rosas, and enjoy a demonstration of the famous Gomera whistling language. Continue to the Garajonay National Park. Evening sailing to Tenerife.

Day 5 : Wednesday- SANTA CRUZ DE TENERIFE

We arrive in Santa Cruz de Tenerife in the morning. Optional half day excursion to Santa Cruz and La Laguna. Beginning in the central Plaza del Adelantado, we visit the Town Hall, the Casa de Anchieta, the Palacio de Nava and the Monastery of Santa Catalina de Siena. Evening sailing to Lanzarote. Overnight at sea.

Day 6 : Thursday - MARINA RUBI-CON (PLAYA BLANCA), LANZA-ROTE

Morning arrival in Lanzarote. Optional full day excursion to Lanzarote during which we will visit the southern part of the island to admire a panoramic view of the El Janubio salt mines and the famous "Lava Coast", "Los Hervideros". We continue to "El Golfo", to visit the Timanfaya National Park. Continue towards La Geria the Lanzarote wine route for wine tasting (included in the optional excursion).

Day 7 : Friday - CORRALEJO PORT, FUERTEVENTURA

Morning arrival in Corralejo Port. Optional half day excursion on the island and discover Betancuria. We will visit a goat farm and find out how Majorero cheeses are prepared and stop in an Aloe Vera factory. Afternoon at leisure with the possibility for a swim at the nearby beach. Late evening sail to Las Palmas de Gran Canaria. Overnight at sea.

Day 8 : Saturday LAS PALMAS DE GRAN CANARIA

Morning arrival - Disembarkation 8 - 9.30 am.

Day 1 : Monday - PRAIA, SAN TIAGO C

Embarkation 4 pm. San Tiago and its capital Praia is the largest and most populated island of the Cape Verde Archipelago. Overnight in port.

Day 2 : Tuesday - PRAIA, SAN TIAGO

After a morning at leisure and lunch on board, the optional afternoon excursion will bring us to Cidade Velha, the Old Portuguese capital. The Museum of Maritime History displays findings from rich shipwrecks. Late in the evening we will sail north to Fogo. Overnight at sea.

Day 3 : Wednesday - SAN FILIPE, FOGO

Early morning arrival in Fogo. Our optional full day excursion will

bring us at the top of the volcano, right at the crater edge. Lunch will be at the crater's village. We visit the city San Felipe and late in the evening we sail to San Nikolau. Overnight at sea.

Day 4 : Thursday - TARRAFAL, SAN NICOLAU

Morning arrival in San Nikolau, a peaceful island with dozens of coffee plantations and friendly residents. Our optional full day tour of the island will include walks near the Monte Gordo volcano, then to the nearby forest and the Faja Valley. Once a vibrant commercial island, it has evolved into a cultural center and Mindelo is one of the most well preserved colonial cities in Cape Verde. Our optional walking excursion will allow you to visit galleries and discover busy restaurants and musical events. Overnight at sea to Maio.

Day 7 : Sunday – MAIO C

Arrival at noon in Maio a calm and relaxed community. Our walking

tour of the city of Vila do Maio will include a visit to the huge Baroque church built by the Portuguese some centuries back. Afternoon excursion. Overnight in port.





Day 1: Saturday – DAKAR, SENEGAL Late afternoon embarkation. After dinner sail towards the Saloun River Delta. Overnicht at sea.

Day 2: Sunday - DJIFFERE - BAN-JUL, THE GAMBIA

We reach the Sine – Saloun Delta in Senegal, a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve. Optional excursion at the primitive fishing village of Djiffere from where we reach Joal Fadiouth. Afternoon sail south to Banjul.

Day 3: Monday - BANJUL - ABUKO NATURE RESERVES, THE GAMBIA

In the morning enjoy a half day excursion to Bakau and a short Banjul Tour unveiling some of the traditions of The Gambia. After lunch we drop anchors at St. James Island. After disembarking by local tenders your local guide will let you in onto the history and secrets James Island.

Day 4: Tuesday - TENDABA, THE GAMBIA C

DAYBYDAY

As Tuesday unfolds, we join some traditional motor pirogues towards Tendaba, starting point of our morning optional excursion. We walk through to Battling as we discover a beautiful landscape which boasts over 250 species of birds and other rare. A relaxed afternoon optional excursion with motor pirogues through the Bao Bolong Wetland Reserve follows.

Day 5: Wednesday - GAMBIA RIVER - KUNTAUR, THE GAMBIA

Early morning sail and arrival to Kuntaur to board a large motor pirogue for a 3 hours optional excursion cruise. We are joined on board by a local national park ranger on Baboon Island. Return to Kuntaur and meet the "Kankurang", a local dance group. Here you will have the opportunity to learn more about a fascinating project, and on some Wednesdays actually experience one of the world's best kept secrets yourself: The Kuntaur Film Festival brings children's films to the local community lacking permanent electricity, using mobile projectors and generators, a project brought to life by the Variety Cruises family, allowing you

the opportunity to join hands together and Get Involved.

Day 6: Thursday - KUNTAUR – JAN-JANBUREH - KAUR, THE GAMBIA

Optional excursion by bus to board the local ferry for a short cruise to Janjanbureh and then back to reach Lamin Koto to experience a local school educating over 100 children using the local knowledge and tools, combined with the support and soft, unobtrusive influence provided by Variety Cruises and her guests. GENERAL INFORMATION

Passengers who have not cruised with Variety Cruises before, will have many questions to ask about the ship, the operation and the cruise program. This section will give you some of the answers to the most frequently asked questions. If you have any queries or need clarification please visit our website, call your travel agent or contact us.

BEFORE YOU EMBARK

Embarkation / Disembarkation

Passengers are requested to be on board at cruise program embarkation times shown or 2 hours prior to departure. Disembarkation is after breakfast at approximately 9am.

Travel Documents

Participants must be in possession of a valid passport (expiring not earlier than one month after cruise ends) and should obtain visas and health certificates where required. All requirements should be confirmed with appropriate government consulate or information office prior to departure.

Luggage and Clothing

Please travel as lightly as possible so as not to restrict space in your cabin. Soft bags are more practical than hard suitcases. Sports or casual clothes are more useful. Plenty of swimwear is required and a pullover or cardigan is recommended for cool evenings. Comfortable walking shoes are suggested when ashore.

Electric Current

Our ship generators provide an electric current of 220 v. Cabins are equipped with European type plugs so please remember to bring an adaptor if necessary.

Health Requirements

Due to safety reasons it is requested that physical disabilities of any kind be advised at time of reservation. It is understood that passengers requiring special attention or treatment will be travelling with their personal escorts. The company retains the right to refuse to embark any pregnant woman beyond the 6th month of pregnancy.

Special Dietary Requirements

Every attempt to meet special dietary requirements will be made provided that such a request is put in writing at least 4 weeks prior to sailing.

Passengers with Special Needs

Variety Cruises ships are not suitable for passengers with special needs. Embarkation gang ways

do not fit all types of wheel chairs. Cabin bathrooms and stair cases are unsuitable for disabled

passengers. Cruise itineraries may include anchorage and tenders to shore where good physical condition is required.

WHILE AT SEA

Daily Program

Each day's schedule will be posted by our cruise coordinator listing necessary information such as arrival/ departure times, meal times, days activities and any other pertinent information. It is understood that the daily program will be given as a guideline and that it is subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances. As for dining, breakfast, lunch or dinner – depending on your daily cruise schedule are served on an open sitting basis at set timings adjusted to best fit day's program.

Emergency Drill

An emergency drill demonstration is conducted by our crew before the ship sails and/or within 24 hours from departure and is to be attended by all passengers. The drill will provide passengers information about the alarm system, the muster station position, their life jackets use and other emergency procedures.

Swim stops

When itineraries allow for a swim stop passengers are requested to carefully read the swimming instructions and attend the ship's briefings for safety.

Motorsailers & Sailing Cruisers

Unless differently notified sails are opened when wind and itinerary schedule allow for a certain sailing time and are mostly used with assistance of the ship's engines.

Valuables

Jewelry, money, documents etc., should be placed in your individual safe deposit boxes or given to the captain who will deposit items in the ship's safe box free of charge. The company and its personnel bear no responsibility for valuables kept by passengers. Passengers are advised to protect personal valuable belongings during tendering and should refrain from leaving such on open decks unattended or during sailings.

Personal Expenses & Funds

EURO is the official currency on board. There is an optional credit system for expenses on board that may be paid/settled at the end of the cruise. Most major currencies payment by American Express, Visa and Mastercard is accepted/ exchanged at their official exchange rate.

Medical Attention

There is no doctor on board any Variety Cruises ships. In case of an emergency, some members of the crew are trained to offer first aid. Medical care is available in all inhabited ports of call visited. In case of discomfort,

please contact a crew member immediately.

Smoking

Smoking is not permitted to any of our passengers or members of the crew in any indoor part of the ship.

Shore Excursions

Shore excursions are not included in the cruise fares and are available according to the cruise schedule/ports of call visited. Details are available in your cabin and provided also on a daily basis by the on board Cruise Coordinator. Shore excursions are subject to shore and weather conditions and based on a minimum participation a minimum participation is required for their materialization.

Tipping

Tipping is at our guests' discretion. As a rule satisfied customers are expected to leave between € 11-14 and US\$ 13-16 per person per day. These tips are distributed to all crew members. Passengers should refrain from tipping individual crew members.

Complaints

Should any problems arise on board please report them first to your Cruise Coordinator and the Captain. Crew members will do their utmost to rectify the situation. Please also ensure that your personal guest questionnaire is filled and placed in the appropriate locked guest questionnaire box. We welcome all your suggestions for improvements as well as your feedback on our cruise operation and on our crew. Complaints that are received by the company 4 weeks after the end of cruise are not acknowledged.

Laundry

Laundry service (machine-washable items) is available only on board the Variety Cruises ships. Further information is available from your cabin steward.

Telephone / Fax

There is a telephone in your cabin for intra ship communication. International calls and fax sending via satellite are available at the bridge and can be arranged through the Captain but are very costly.

Games and Library

Games and a selection of books are available on board. Please ask your Cruise Coordinator and ensure that they are returned timely, as a courtesy to your fellow passengers.

Internet & Television

Internet access is available at a charge. Please contact the Hotel Manager or the Cruise Coordinator.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Discover the World Marketing Travel Pty Ltd (DTWM)

Trading as Discover Travel Shop (DTS) is not itself a carrier or hotelier nor do we carry on business as an airline, a shipping company, a coach or bus company, a railway, a hotelier or provider of any kind of transport or

accommodation. DTS is an agent only and exercises every care in the selection of reputable airlines, shipping companies, coach and bus operators, railways, hoteliers, and other suppliers of the various travel and associated services which are used on these tours. It is important to note therefore that all bookings made by DTS on behalf of passengers are subject to the terms and conditions and limitations of liability imposed by such airlines, shipping companies, coach and bus companies, railway, hoteliers and other service providers whose services are utilised, most of which limit or exclude liability in respect of death, personal injury and delay and loss of or damage to property including baggage.

DTS strongly recommends that you check the terms and conditions in your contract with the airline, shipping, coach and/or bus companies concerned before making the booking, as you will be bound by them once you have paid the earlier of your booking deposit or the tour price. DTS also strongly

recommends that you take our comprehensive travel insurance against those and other risks (see point 12 below).

DTS always does its best to make sure that your holiday arrangements are satisfactory and DTS accepts liability for, but only to the extent of, any loss or damage sustained by you as the result of our negligence or that of our employees. However, DTS does not accept any liability whatsoever of nature for the acts, omissions or defaults whether negligent or otherwise of any such airline, shipping company, coach or bus company, railway, hotelier, or other person providing services in connection with your holiday pursuant to a contract between any one of them and yourself (which may or may not be evidenced in writing by the issue of a ticket, voucher, coupon or the like). NOTE: Nothing in the provisions of this clause shall diminish, vary or reduce any right or remedy which you may have by virtue of the provisions of the Australian Trade Practices Act or any other applicable consumer protection legislation.

2. Deposit and Final Payments

a) You must pay a non-refundable 25% Deposit within six (6) days of receiving your booking confirmation.

b) If the deposit has not been received by DTS within the time specified, the booking is subject to cancellation without notice.

c) You must pay the balance owing no later than 70 days prior to departure. d) For bookings made within 70 days of departure, immediate full payment is required six (6) days from confirmation.

3. Credit Card Surcharge

If you pay by credit card, a fee will be charged to your tour price. Fees differ by card type. Contact us to obtain applicable surcharge fee for your card type.

4. Cancellation Fees

For any cancellation of your holiday arrangements made by you prior to the commencement of the services booked by DTS, the following cancellation fees will apply:

*Written notification must be received by DTS. Cancellation takes affect the day we receive your letter or email. Cancellations received during weekends, holidays or after 5.00p.m. on a business day will attract cancellation penalties that are in effect from the following business day.

**Please note: DTS can only be responsible for refunding amounts actually received. If cancellation fees are charged by pre/post hotels, tour operators, airlines, or service suppliers, these cancellation fees will be deducted from any refund made.

5. Prices

a) All prices shown are in Australian Dollars and are per person, based on double occupancy and are current at time of printing (01 August 2017).

b) Prices were calculated using foreign currency exchange rates. Where exchange rate fluctuations occur of more than 2.5%, or any other increase in the price of services provided which are beyond the control of DTS including any fuel surcharges, local and foreign taxes, we reserve the right to adjust the package prices accordingly, at any time up until the delivery of service, irrespective of reservation payment status. Acceptance of this arrangement is a condition of booking.

c) Prices are subject to availability at time of booking, are capacity controlled and may be withdrawn at any time without notice.

d) Prices are based on a standard room in a superior hotel unless otherwise stated. Additional cost will be incurred for upgrades to another room type or hotel if requested by you.

e) Prices for cruise components are based on seasonal-voyage departure date on lowest cabin category (please refer to individual ship cabin categories and deck plans) on selected sailings only. Prices vary based on date of booking, season and sailing date. Prices shown are for the lowest priced sailing of multiple departure dates.

6. Airline Arrangements/Cancellations

a) Airfare prices and conditions are subject to change or withdrawal without notice until ticketed.

b) Full payment is required before tickets can be issued. Some airfares are non refundable.

7. What's Included In Your Holiday Cost

Meals (included meals onboard your cruise vary depending on cruise itinerary), port charges/ taxes, accommodation, sightseeing and transfers as stated in the day-by-day itinerary.

8. What's Not Included

Flights other than specified flights detailed in the day-by-day itinerary; meals other than onboard voyage or as stated in itinerary; travel insurance; shore excursions (other than specified); items of a personal nature; passport costs or visa fees (if required); vaccinations (if required); transfers (other than specified); hotel porterage (unless specified); tipping onboard the ship; driver and tour guide gratuities. Accommodation necessitated by flight schedules is not included in package price.

9. Force Majeure

DTS is unable to accept liability or pay compensation where the performance or prompt performance of our contractual obligation is prevented or affected by reason of circumstances amounting to force majeure (i.e. any event which we or the supplier(s) of the service(s) could not, even with due care foresee or avoid). Such events may include, but are not limited to, war, threat of war or civil commotions, riots, terrorist activity, industrial dispute, natural or nuclear disaster, adverse weather, fire, flood, drought, government action, airport and port regulations and closures, technical transportation problems, maintenance to vessels, scheduling of transport and similar events outside our control.

10. Travel Insurance

DTS strongly recommends that you take out comprehensive travel insurance against those risks as mentioned in Point 1 and other risks. Travel Insurance should be in force for the entire duration of your holiday, covering at least the cancellation of the booking and providing medical cover for illness or injury and repatriation while overseas. You will receive a booking form requesting you to provide DTS with the name of your insurer, together with their 24-hour emergency number.

11. Amendments

Should a change be made by you after your initial booking request has been confirmed and deposited, a charge of \$100 per person will apply for each amendment. Any other fees/charges imposed upon DTS by outside suppliers, will be added to this. Amendments requested within 70 days of cruise and tour departure will incur applicable cancellation penalties as detailed herein (refer to point 4 and 6).

12. Variations

In the event of unusual or unforeseen circumstances beyond our control, which require DTS to make necessary changes to your travel arrangements, we reserve the right to cancel or reschedule departures and itineraries. Where it is necessary to change a hotel DTS reserves the right to substitute accommodation of at least a similar standard.

13. Single Travellers

a) Prices quoted in this brochure for SeaTour extensions are on a twin share basis. If your booking is not a twin share booking we will advise you of the applicable single supplement at the time of confirmation.

b) Prices quoted in this brochure for specific city Hotel Stays provide per room costs for single travellers, based on lowest season standard room accommodation in each hotel. Hotel rates vary depending on date and day of travel.

c) A limited number of single rooms/suites/cabins are available by request at the time of booking. Note: single rooms/suites/cabins are usually smaller and often only have one single bed.

14. Brochure Validity
