ATHENS ROUND-TRIP 8 DAYS/7 NIGHTS

Board Mega Yacht Harmony G and journey to lands that will stir in you echoes of great rulers, such as Agamemnon, ancient Minoan civilisations and legends of Achilles and Hercules. The Classical Greece cruise is one of our most popular itineraries and includes the 'must-see' islands of Santorini, Mykonos and Crete, plus the gems of Kythira, Monemvasia and Nafplion, where you'll be able to shop endlessly in narrow island streets for Greek gold jewellery, ceramics and crafts, and also find that perfect island beach. Enjoy longer stays in port so you can become acquainted with the famous Greek island nightlife.

Day 1: Athens (Marina Zea) - Palaia Epidauros, Greece

Embark Motor Sailer Galileo for your seven night cruise. This evening arrive in Palaia (old) Epidauros and overnight onboard.

Day 2: Palaia Epidauros - Nafplion, Greece

This morning, we recommend you visit Ancient Epidauros, known as a healing sanctuary and birthplace of Apollo's son Asclepius. An afternoon sail to Nafplion, a gorgeous town riddled with restaurants and boutiques in its narrow streets. Overnight onboard in Nafplion.

Day 3: Nafplion - Monemvasia, Greece

Nafplion's rabbit-warren streets are the perfect opportunity to get purposefully lost amongst its cafes and little shops, or a visit to Mycenae and Agamemnon's tomb. This afternoon, sail to the remarkable medieval fortified town of Monemvasia for a short visit and explore the Byzantine and Venetian architecture.

Day 4: Gythion, Greece

An ancient Spartan fishing port, Gythion is a quaint little town. Gear up for a slower pace and enjoy the tranquillity, or perhaps take the optional ship's tour to the spectacular caves at Diros with their stalactites and stalagmites, and the distinctive Mani Peninsula.

Day 5: Pylos, Greece

Pylos is a picture-perfect seaside town on the southwest corner of the Peloponnese, known for an important naval battle which led to the independence of Greece in 1829. Close by is Nestor's Palace, an ancient palace so-called from Homer's Iliad.

Day 6: Katakolon - Itea, Greece

Offering local seaside cafes and shops, we recommend you slip outside sleepy Katakolon to visit Olympia, the ancient site and birthplace of the first Olympic Games. A visit here is like stepping back 2,000 years. This afternoon sail for Itea, where you will overnight onboard.

Day 7: Itea - Athens (Marina Zea), Greece

The town of Itea is the gateway to Delphi, one of the most revered sites in the ancient world. Known for its wealth and reputation, leaders from across the Mediterranean would come to consult Delphi's oracle who had the ability to prophecy the future. Set sail for Athens transiting through the incredible Corinth Canal. Overnight onboard in Marina Zea.

Day 8: Athens (Marina Zea), Greece

Following breakfast onboard bid a fond farewell to your ship mates and disembark Galileo.

Day 1: Athens (Marina Zea) - Kea, Greece

Embark Mega Yacht Harmony G for your seven night cruise. This evening, your ship arrives in Kea's tiny port of Korrisia, where you can explore at leisure.

Day 2: Delos - Mykonos, Greece

Stop at Delos this morning for an optional tour to the archaeological site of Delos. Continue to Mykonos with a swim stop* along the way. Shop, swim and sample Mykonos nightlife. Overnight onboard in Mykonos.

Day 3: Santorini, Greece

Cameras at the ready for your spectacular arrival in to Santorini. Stroll the streets, visit the plethora of shops, take the bus to Oia, discover a favourite beach, visit an ancient Minoan city or opt to have lunch with incredible views.

Day 4: Rethymnon, Crete, Greece

Arrive at Crete's lively port of Rethymnon. Meandering through the narrow maze of streets in the old quarter, or perhaps join the ship's optional tour to Knossos the ancient palace and capital of Minoan Crete.

Day 5: Kythira, Greece

Morning at sea and swim stop* as you cruise to the lesser known island of Kythira. Spend your evening at leisure enjoying the picturesque town of Chora. Overnight onboard in Kythira.

Day 1: Athens (Marina Zea) - Poros, Greece

Welcome aboard Motor Sailer Galileo and set sail for your seven night voyage. Stop this evening at Poros, a small island thriving with activity and boasting several inviting restaurants and shops.

Day 2: Poliegos - Folegandros, Greece

Known for its beautiful beaches, enjoy a swim stop* and deck BBQ at the small island of Poliegos. Weigh anchor and sail for Folegandros, a quaint Greek island where time appears to have stopped. Stroll the winding streets up to Hora Village where we recommend dinner in one of the many restaurants.

Day 3: Santorini, Greece

Be on deck for a spectacular arrival and dramatic scene that is Santorini. Towering above you are 300 metre cliff walls crowned by two magical white villages which appear to cling effortlessly to the edge. Dine in one of the restaurants with incredible views, spend the day at the beach, explore an ancient Minoan settlement, or shop for gold jewellery. Overnight onboard in Santorini.

Day 4: Antiparos - Paros, Greece

A morning swim stop* at Antiparos before arriving at Paros around noon. You'll have time to visit the quaint village of Naoussa before showing your dancing skills at our famous Greek Night. Overnight onboard in Paros.

Day 5: Delos - Mykonos, Greece

Your ship stops at Delos. An opportunity to participate in an optional tour of Delos before sailing the short distance to Mykonos. Whether you're a serious shopper, people watcher, beach goer or searching for nightlife, Mykonos will not disappoint. Overnight onboard in Mykonos.

Day 6: Syros, Greece

Awake and refresh yourself with another morning swim stop* before arriving at the 'Queen of the Cyclades', the island of Syros. An important port town, you'll discover neoclassic buildings, old mansions and white houses cascading down to the harbour. Overnight onboard in Syros.

Day 7: Kythnos - Athens (Marina Zea), Greece

Sailing to the western Cyclades, arrive in Kythnos and enjoy a swim stop in Kolones Bay before sailing via Cape Sounion and the Temple of Poseidon to Athens. Overnight onboard.

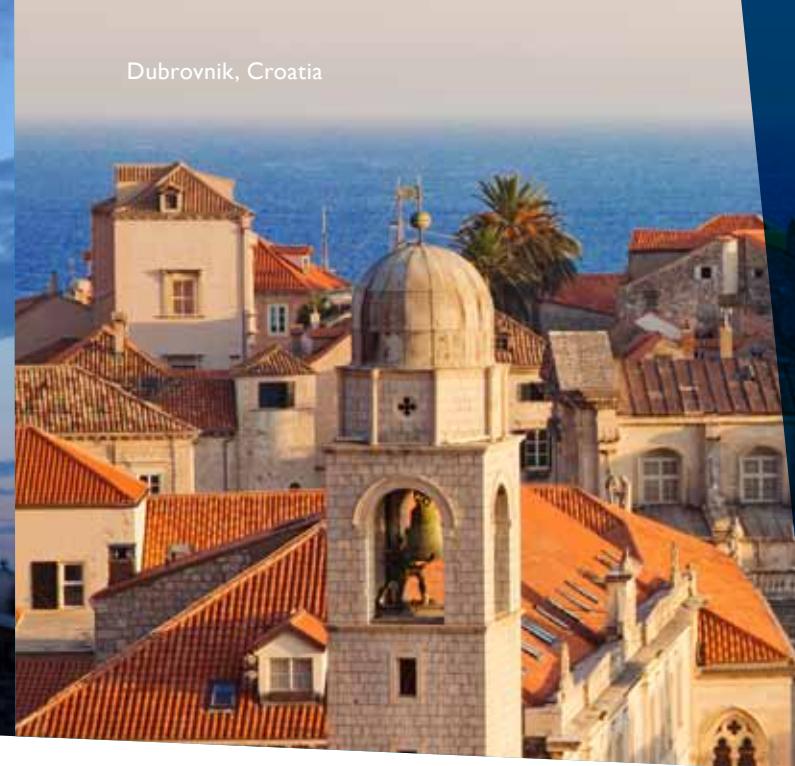

DUBROVNIK ROUND-TRIP 8 DAYS/7 NIGHTS

Visiting no less than four countries, each with its own traditions and culture, your voyage aboard Motor Sailer Panorama will begin on the Dalmatian Riviera and head south to Ionian Isles of Greece. Hugging the Adriatic coast touch the shores of Albania with its Roman – Hellenistic heritage, and Montenegro, a land of sailors and adventure. A highlight will no doubt be your time in Dubrovnik and Korcula, Croatia, both of which will transport you back to medieval times.

Day 1: Dubrovnik, Croatia

Step aboard Motor Sailer Panorama for your seven night cruise. Welcome dinner and overnight onboard in Dubrovnik.

Day 2: Korcula, Croatia

Cruise the Dalmatian Riviera. Your yacht anchors for a swim stop* before continuing to enchanting Korcula. Venture out to visit the Old Town, a medieval walled city dominated by the splendid St. Marks Cathedral, or head out of town to visit fishermen's villages and terraced vineyards known for their white wines.

Day 3: Bar, Montenegro

Begin your day with an invigorating swim stop before arriving in Bar at midday, where we recommend you visit Stari Bar (Old Bar). Resting on a hill, Stari Bar will launch you back in time when Nemanjic, Illryians, Romans, Venetians and Turks ruled.

Day 4: Paxos, Greece

Relax onboard with a swim stop* and deck BBQ lunch, arriving in Paxos early afternoon where your ship will stay overnight. Paxos, an island of endless olive groves and an unhurried lifestyle, will warm you with genuine Greek hospitality. Overnight onboard in Paxos.

Day 5: Corfu, Greece

Cruise to Corfu, lying at the entrance of the Adriatic Sea. A mountainous island, Corfu boasts impressive landscapes, golden beaches, Byzantine churches, museums, Venetian fortresses, shopping and varied bars and taverns. Overnight onboard in Corfu.

Day 6: Saranda, Albania

Saranda is known for its beauty and as a gateway to picturesque mountains, springs and beaches. Perhaps venture to the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Butrint or drop a stone into the archaeological phenomenon of the Blue Eye. Mid-afternoon sail towards Kotor and relax aboard your beautiful yacht. Overnight onboard in Kotor.

Day 7: Kotor, Montenegro

Welcome to Kotor, a city with seafaring stories dating back to the Dark Ages. Numerous monuments and wonderful medieval architecture have earned Kotor a UNESCO World Natural and Historical Heritage Site listing. Overnight onboard in Kotor.

Day 8: Dubrovnik, Croatia

Disembark this morning where you have the option to extend your stay.

MALAGA TO LISBON OR LISBON TO MALAGA**
8 DAYS/7 NIGHTS

New for 2017 Motor Sailer Panorama II will cruise the magical sun-drenched coasts of Spain and Portugal with a visit to Gibraltar. Home to the New World's great explorers, Spain offers an exceptional journey into past and present, where cultural paths have crossed from Europe and Africa, blending into a mix of Moorish and Spanish splendour. A day in Portugal rewards you with a castle, monastery, mosque, cathedral, cobblestone streets and artisans, and a visit to the 'Rock' provides a taste of British Gibraltar.

Day 1: Malaga, Spain

Board **Motor Sailer Panorama II** and become acquainted with your fellow travellers. Dinner and overnight onboard in port.

Day 2: Motril, Spain

Surrounded by fertile land and pleasant beaches, Motril's attractions include a 16thc. Sugar Mill and Museum, town hall and 16thc. church and is a great gateway to several scenic villages. Pick of the day is a full-day tour to Granada and the Alhambra Palace, a Moorish complex of gardens, rooms and chambers.

Day 3: Porto Banus, Spain

Porto Banus is an upmarket resort close to famous Marbella and is typical of the Costa del Sol. Not far away is Ronda, steeped in history, and perched atop the El Tajo Canyon, it makes for an incredible setting and is home to the oldest bullring in Spain. Overnight onboard in Porto Banus.

Day 4: Gibraltar, British Overseas Territory

Just 7sq. Km. Gibraltar or the "Rock" was first settled by the Moors in the Middle Ages and from the 1700s a British territory. Take a cable car ride to the summit of Gibraltar, where you can have fun with the mischievous Barbary Apes at the middle station and enjoy the scenic vistas.

Day 5: Cadiz, Spain

A highlight of your cruise is two days in beautiful Cadiz, the entry point to many incredible places. We recommend you journey to Seville, home of flamenco and a series of must-see sights, such as the majestic gothic cathedral, Alcazar Palace, Andalusian gardens and historic district of Santa Cruz. Overnight onboard in Cadiz.

Day 6: Cadiz, Spain

Energise yourself with an optional tour to Jerez de la Frontera. Famous for its wines, flamenco and horses, this white village in the hills is the perfect place to stroll, take in a cafe and shop. In Cadiz, explore narrow streets of blue and white buildings, bursting with historic wealth.

Day 7: Portimao, Portugal

A busy coastal city, Portimao offers shopping, cafes and vibrant locals. Far removed from the hectic pace of Portimao, visit Silves, with its 13thc. cathedral and red Moorish castle looming above, before heading to picturesque Monchique.

Day 8: Lisbon, Portugal

Disembark this morning.

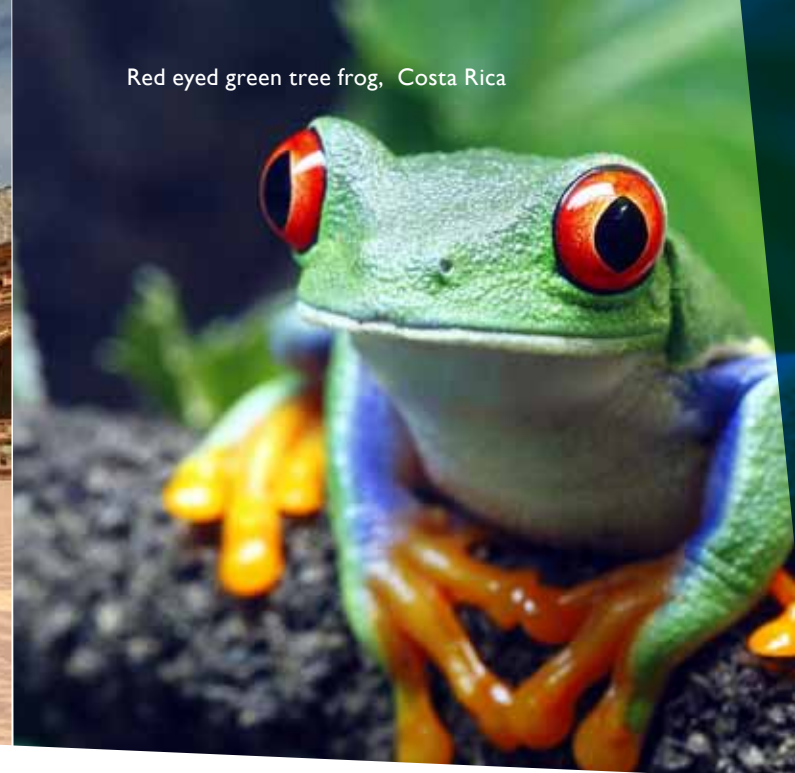

PUNTARENAS TO PANAMA OR PANAMA TO PUNTARENAS
10 DAYS/9 NIGHTS

Embark on Mega Yacht Callisto, for a 10 day tropical escapade from the Pacific Ocean to Panama's famous canal. Such events may include, but are not limited to, war, threat of war or civil commotions, riots, terrorist activity, industrial dispute, natural or nuclear disaster, adverse weather, fire, flood, drought, government action, airport and port regulations and closures, technical transportation problems, maintenance to vessels, scheduling of transport and similar events outside our control.

10. Travel Insurance
